1914-15	11/19/1914	Appendix C	Fixing an annual tax of twenty five (\$0.25) cents from all electric lights, telegraph, or telephone companies, individuals, or public service Company maintaining poles upon which wires are strung for the purpose of conducting electricity or transmitting messages
